- (ii) *The vacancies created after closing of the counseling for 1st Phase will be upgraded first by the already registered candidates who have given option for the up-gradation at both the study centers. The remaining vacancies at both the centers will be filled by the candidates of waiting list on merit.*
- (iii) *The candidates who will be upgraded after 1st Phase of counseling will not be permitted to retain their original seat and center allotted to them.*

4.5 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

4.5.1 Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) or equivalent with at least 50% marks for UR and OBC-NCL categories and 45% Marks for SC/ST category, PwD, Kashmiri Migrants & Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir valley.

OR

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Health and Physical Education with at least 50% marks for UR and OBC-NCL categories and 45% Marks for SC/ST category, PwD, Kashmiri Migrants & Kashmiri Pandit/Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir valley.

4.5.2 The reservation of seats and/or relaxation in qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC-NCL and other categories shall be as per the rule of Government of India.

4.5.3 For any other relaxation related to age and percentage of marks, the advisory issued by Government of India from time to time will be applicable.

Note :

- (i) *All the candidates appearing as Supplementary / Compartment in qualifying examinations for the session 2024-25 are eligible to appear in Entrance Test but their final results must be declared on or before the last date of Registration.*
- (ii) *Candidates should note that no “CALL LETTER” for the Entrance Test shall be sent to them by Post. They should download the admit card Online after filling up the Online Admission Form.*

4.6 CHOICE OF STUDY CENTER

All the candidates applying for M.P.Ed. Admission shall give their choice of study center.

- Study Center-1 : LNIFE, Gwalior
Study Center-2 : LNIFE-NERC, Guwahati

Note : *There shall be no migration permitted from one study center to another study center for entire duration of course.*

4.7 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission shall be made on merit based on Marks obtained in the Written Test and Sports Skill Proficiency Test as per the policy of the Institute.

4.8 DIRECT ADMISSION

4.8.1 Direct admission will be provided to the candidates who have represented India in designated International Championship such as Junior and Senior World Championships, Junior and Senior World Cups, Junior and Senior Asian Championships, Junior and Senior Asian Cups, Common Wealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian Games, SAF Games, World School Games/World Schools Championship in the following games and sports:

A. LNIFE, Gwalior

Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Cricket, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power Lifting/Weight Lifting, Shooting (10M pistol & Rifle), Squash, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball Wrestling & Yoga.

B. LNIFE-NERC, Guwahati

Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Cycling, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power

Lifting/Weight Lifting, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball & Yoga.

Note :

(iii) *The Test and Study center for Archery and Cycling will be only at LNIFE-NERC, Guwahati.*

(iv) *The Test and Study center for Boxing, Shooting (10M pistol & Rifle), Squash and Wrestling will be only at LNIFE, Gwalior.*

4.8.2 Representation shall be in such games/sports, which are approved and funded by MYAS/IOA. Such participation must be after 01st July, 2021. All such candidates who will fulfill above-mentioned criteria are entitled or will be granted direct admission.

4.8.3 All such candidates who wish to be considered for direct admission shall mandatorily give an application in writing with all the documents along with sports achievements certificate. Such candidate must give written examination conducted by CUET.

4.9 FEMALE CANDIDATES

Married women are eligible for admission, but if she conceives during the course, she will have to discontinue her studies for at least one Academic Year. She can join back afresh from the beginning of the semester keeping the Guidelines pertaining to the Maximum Duration of the course in mind.

4.10 FEE STRUCTURE

Each student shall pay the fee as given in **Annexure-15 (I-II).**

4.11 COURSE INFORMATION

Duration of the course is 2 years (four-semesters). A candidate must complete the Course and pass the final examination within four academic years from the first admission to this programme. During the four-semester course, students will be taught/ provided experience in the following areas:
