- Total number of candidates for counseling shall be 50% more than the available seats in each category.
- The vacancies created after closing the counseling of 1<sup>st</sup> Phase will be upgraded first by the already registered candidates who have given option for the up-gradation at both the study centers. Remaining vacancies, at both the centers will be filled by the candidates from waiting list on merit basis.

(iii) *The candidates who were upgraded after 1<sup>st</sup> Phase of counseling will not be permitted to retain their original seat and center allotted to them.*

### 3.4 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A candidate shall be eligible to appear in admission test:

3.4.1 If he/she has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) or Intermediate/equivalent examination from any recognized Education Board/ University etc. with at least 50% Marks for UR and OBC-NCL categories and 45% Marks for SC/ST category, PwD, Kashmiri Migrants & Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir valley.

3.4.2 The maximum age of the candidate shall be 21 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2024 which shall be further relaxed up to 3 years for OBC-NCL Candidates and 5 years for SC/ST Candidates.

- 3.4.3 For any other relaxation related to age and percentage of marks, the advisory issued by Government of India from time to time will be applicable.

**Note :**

- (i) *All the candidates appearing in Supplementary / Compartment in qualifying examinations for the session 2024-25 are eligible to appear in Entrance Test, but their final results must be declared on or before the last date of Registration.*
- (ii) *Candidates should note that no "CALL LETTER" for the Entrance Test shall be sent to them by Post. They should download the admit card Online after filling up the Online Admission Form.*

### 3.5 CHOICE OF STUDY CENTER

All the candidates applying for B.P.Ed. admission shall give their choice of study center.

Study Center-1 : LNIFE, Gwalior  
Study Center-2 : LNIFE-NERC, Guwahati

**Note:** *There shall be no migration permitted from one study center to another study center for entire duration of course.*

### 3.6 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 3.6.1 The admission process for B.P.Ed. will comprise of three components Written Test, Physical Fitness Test and Sports Skill Proficiency Test. The Merit will be based on aggregate of Written Test and Sports Skill Proficiency Test :

**Note :** *Candidates if found absent in any above mentioned test will be disqualified.*

- 3.6.2 **SPORTS SKILL PROFICIENCY TEST** for admission to B.P.Ed. program will be conducted at two centers i.e. LNIFE Gwalior and LNIFE-NERC Guwahati in below mentioned games/sports:

**A. LNIFE, Gwalior:**

Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Cricket, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power Lifting/Weight Lifting, Shooting (10M pistol & Rifle), Squash, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball Wrestling & Yoga.

**B. LNIFE, NERC, Guwahati:**

Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Cycling, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power Lifting/Weight Lifting, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball & Yoga.

- 3.6.3 **PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST** will be conducted at two centers LNIFE, Gwalior and LNIFE-NERC, Guwahati. Marks will be awarded in Physical Fitness on the basis of performance in following four events (400 marks) :-

- (a) 50 meters Sprint (b) Standing Broad Jump  
(c) Over Head Back Throw (d) 1000 meters Run/Walk.

The norms to convert the performance into points are given in **Annexure-10 to 13.**

**Note :**

- (i) *Candidates if found absent in any test event/events will be disqualified.*
- (ii) *Qualifying marks for Physical Fitness Test is 60% for UR/EWS/OBC-NCL and 55% for SC/ST.*
- (iii) *At the time of Physical Fitness Test and Sports Skill Proficiency Test, candidate should abide by the guidelines issued by the Government of India/concerned State Government regarding COVID-19.*

### **3.7 DIRECT ADMISSION**

3.7.1 Direct admission will be provided to the candidates who have represented India in designated International Championship such as Junior and Senior World Championships, Junior and Senior World Cups, Junior and Senior Asian Championships, Junior and Senior Asian Cups, Common Wealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian Games, SAF Games, World School Games/World Schools Championship in the following games and sports:

**A. LNIPE, Gwalior**

Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Cricket, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power Lifting/Weight Lifting, Shooting (10M pistol & Rifle), Squash, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball Wrestling & Yoga.

**B. LNIPE-NERC, Guwahati**

Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Cricket, Cycling, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Power Lifting/Weight Lifting, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball & Yoga.

**Note :**

- (i) *The Test and Study center for Archery and Cycling will be only at LNIPE-NERC, Guwahati.*
- (ii) *The Test and Study center for Boxing, Shooting (10M pistol & Rifle), Squash and Wrestling will be only at LNIPE, Gwalior.*

3.7.2 Representation shall be in such games/sports, which are approved and funded by MYAS/IOA. Such participation must be after 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2022. All such candidates who will fulfill above-mentioned criteria are entitled or will be granted direct admission.

3.7.3 All such candidates who wish to be considered for direct admission shall mandatorily give an application in writing with all the documents along with sports achievements certificate. Such candidate must give written examination conducted by CUET.

**Note:**

- (i) *The candidates with such participation in Sports/Games will be given age relaxation of 3 years, which shall be applicable to each and every category i.e. UR, OBC-NCL, SC & ST. The age will be reckoned as on 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2025.*
- (ii) *Participation of applicant in any kind of International Invitational Tournaments shall not be considered for Direct Admission.*

### 3.8 FEMALE CANDIDATES

Married women are not eligible for admission.

### 3.9 FEE STRUCTURE

Each Student shall pay the prescribed fee as given in **Annexure-14 (I-IV)**.

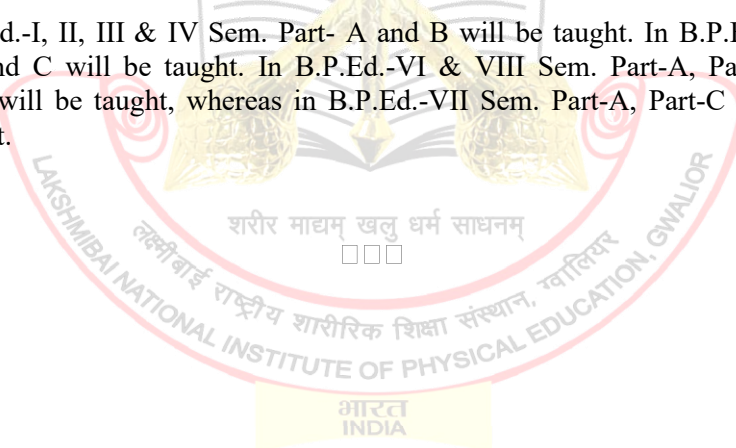
**Note:** Fee for MOOC will be paid by the student separately.

### 3.10 COURSE INFORMATION

Duration of the course is 4 years (eight-semesters). A candidate must complete the course and pass the final examination within six academic years from the first admission to this programme. During the eight-semesters course, the students will be taught / provided experience in the following areas:

PART-A	Theory Course (Core & Elective Course)
PART-B	Activity Course
PART-C	Internship
PART-D	Sports Specialization

In B.P.Ed.-I, II, III & IV Sem. Part- A and B will be taught. In B.P.Ed.-V Sem. Part- A, B, and C will be taught. In B.P.Ed.-VI & VIII Sem. Part-A, Part-B, Part-C and Part- D will be taught, whereas in B.P.Ed.-VII Sem. Part-A, Part-C and Part- D will be taught.
