6.3 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Any graduate with at least 50% marks [45% for SC/ST candidates and Kashmiri Migrants & Kashmiri Pandit/Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir valley] is eligible for admission test.

Note:

- (i) All the candidates appearing as Supplementary / Compartment in qualifying examinations for the session 2024-25 are eligible to appear in Entrance Test but their final results must be declared on or before the last date of Registration.
- (ii) Candidates should note that no "call letter" for the Entrance Test shall be sent to them by Post. They should report in the Institute on said date after filling up the Admission Form.

6.4 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

6.4.1 Admission shall be made on merit basis on Marks obtained in the Written Test as per the policy of the Institute.

6.5 FEMALE CANDIDATES
