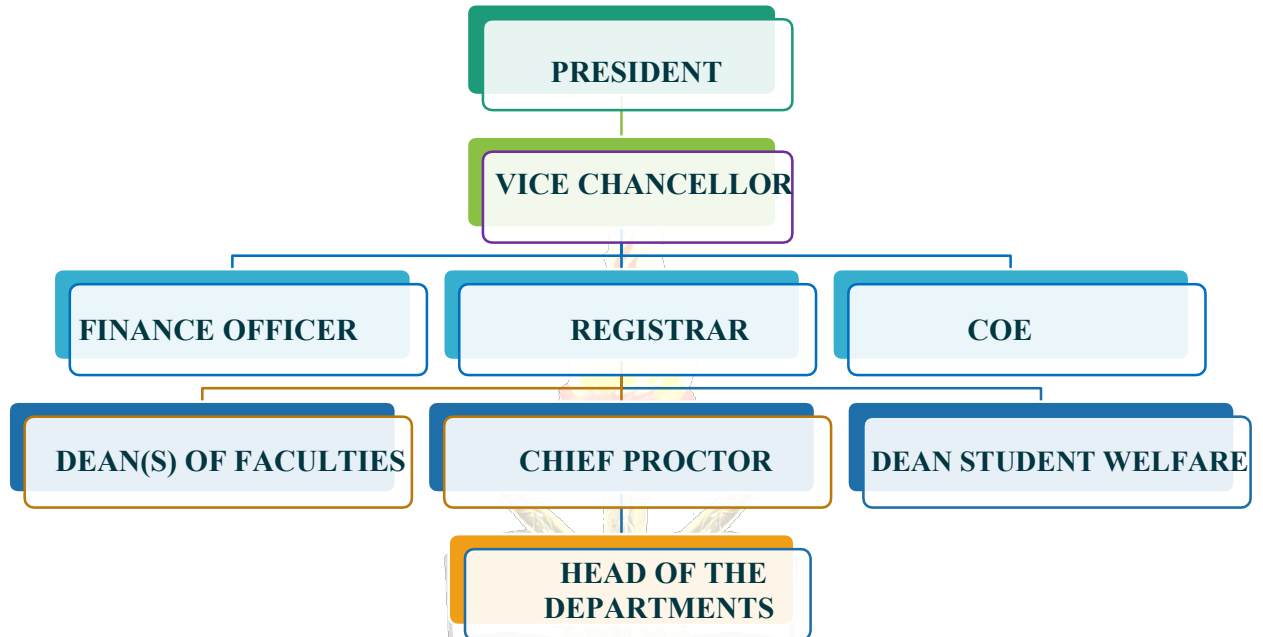

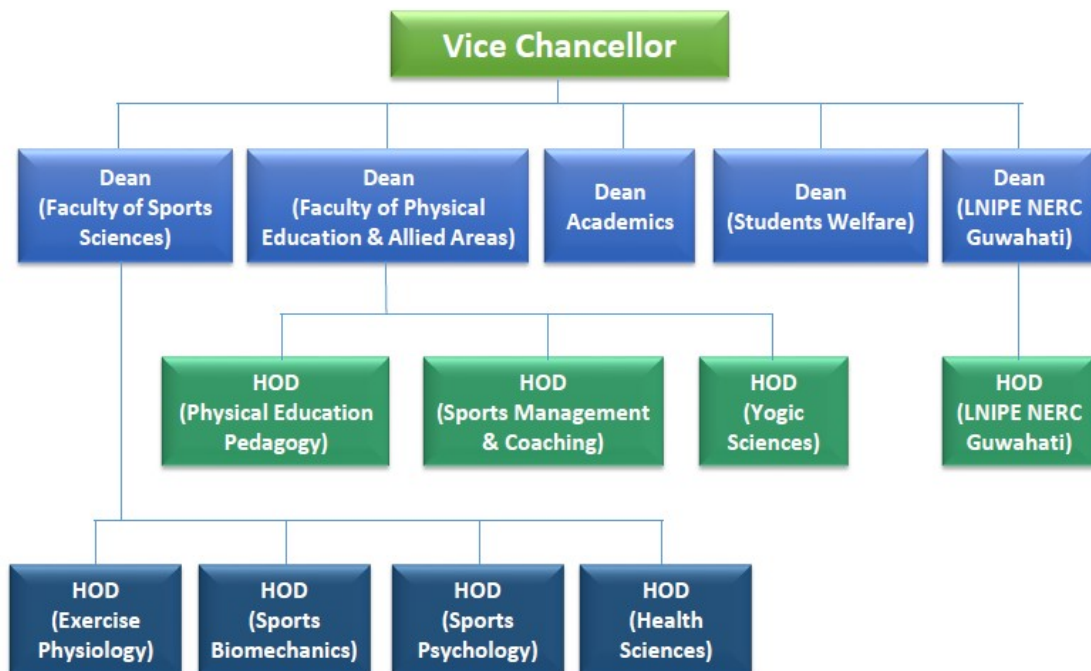

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1. LNIPE AT A GLANCE

1.1 ABOUT LNIPE

- 1.1.1 Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE), Gwalior was established by the Ministry of Education & Culture, Government of India as Lakshmibai College of Physical Education (LCPE) in August 1957, and the centenary year of the War of Independence under the able leadership of Padma Shri Dr. P.M. Joseph. It is located at Gwalior, where Rani Lakshmibai of Jhansi, a valiant heroine of the war, had laid her life during the First Freedom Struggle in 1857.
- 1.1.2 The Institute started as an affiliated college of Vikram University, Ujjain and then came into the fold of Jiwaji University, Gwalior in 1964. The Institute was given a status of national importance, and hence it was renamed Lakshmibai National College of Physical Education (LNCPE) in 1973. In recognition of its unique services and character and to facilitate its further growth, the college was conferred the status of an 'Autonomous College' of Jiwaji University, Gwalior in 1982.
- 1.1.3 In further recognition of the unique educational services rendered by the Institute in the field of Physical Education, Sports and Research, the Govt. of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development conferred the status of a "Deemed to be University" in September 1995 under Section 3 of U.G.C. Act, 1956. Hence, the Institute again renamed as Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE). The Institute is the only "Deemed to be University" in the field of Physical Education in India and enjoys a unique place of its kind in South East Asia. शरीर माद्यम् खलु धर्म साधनम्
- 1.1.4 The main purpose of establishing this Institute was to upgrade the status of Physical Education by producing quality teachers and leaders through graduate and post-graduate courses. For the first time in the country, three years' Bachelor of Physical Education (BPE) was started in 1957 and two years' Master of Physical Education (MPE) in 1963. In 1980, the then college reached yet another milestone and became the first Institution in India to have offered a one-year programme of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Physical Education. The Institute also admits candidates for Ph.D. programs on a regular basis. The Institute offers various Certificate/Diploma/PG Diploma courses in different disciplines of Physical Education and Sports. The Institute also offers some courses on Online Distance Learning mode (ODL).
- 1.1.5 The duration of Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.E.) course was initially three years. To bring it at par with other professional degree courses, as also to match the international standards, the duration of the course was extended to four years and renamed as Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed. 4-year Integrated). The National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE) has accorded recognition to this course. The 4-semester M.P.Ed. Degree Course also has recognition from the NCTE.
- 1.1.6 The Institute has been certified to the parameters of Integrated Management System (IMS) comprising of ISO 9001 (Quality Management System), ISO 14001 (Environmental Management System) and OHSAS 18001 (Occupational Health and Safety).

1.2 CAMPUSE'S

1.2.1 LNIPE, Gwalior

1.2.1.1 The Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) campus is located in Shakti Nagar, on Race Course Road, at distance of about one kilometer from Gwalior Railway Station/Bus Stand. Gwalior is situated on the Agra-Mumbai national highway and on the main North-South rail route, about 320 km from New Delhi.

1.2.1.2 The Institute campus covers an area of about 153 acres and is residential. The buildings of the Institute consist of Academic Block, Laboratories, Research Block, Language Lab, Auditorium and Administrative Block. A state of the art Library Building with all modern facilities is available in the Campus, for the use of Staff, Students, Researchers and others. There are seven Boys Hostels & four Girls Hostels; separate Mess for boys and girls, Health Center. Sports facilities ranging from an Indoor and outdoor Swimming Pool, two Indoor Gymnasium Complexes, Fitness Center, Judo Hall, Table Tennis Hall, Weight Lifting & Weight Training Halls, Squash Rackets Complex, Air-Conditioned Auditorium and Unique Multipurpose Hall for Badminton, Basketball and Volleyball. It also Houses a Climbing Wall, Shooting Range, Boxing Ring and Skating Rink. The Institute has also several other well laid Play Fields for Outdoor Games and Sports like Synthetic Hockey Field, Synthetic Track & Field, Cricket field with Indoor Pitch, Football fields, Handball courts, Basketball courts, Volleyball courts, Tennis courts, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Naturopathy Lab etc.

The Institute's Library stocked with Professional Books and Literature. It subscribes to several Professional and Research Journals/Magazines/ Periodicals and is undoubtedly the best of its kind in India. The Research Laboratories are also well equipped with Modern and Sophisticated Equipment's to cater to the Scholarly needs of the students. The Institute also runs a UGC-HRDC to conduct orientation/refresher/various short-term courses for in-service teachers from all over the country.

1.2.1.3 The campus has a sufficient number of Residential Quarters to house its Faculty, Officers, and other Employees. The Campus also has fully furnished Guest Houses, Facility Center, Workshop, Bank Branch with ATM Facility and Post Office.

1.2.2 LNIPE-NERC GUWAHATI

1.2.2.1 The Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education, North East Regional Centre, Guwahati has been established in 2009-10 after approval from Government of India vide letter No. 2-10/2009-ID dated 20.08.2009 and signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between Government of Assam and LNIPE on 14th May 2010.

1.2.2.2 The LNIPE, NERC, Guwahati is located at Tepesia Sports Complex, Sonapur-782402, Guwahati on the outskirts of Guwahati City (Assam) at half kilometer distance away from Guwahati – Dimapur National Highway 37, which was one of the venue for the 33rd National Games, 2007. LNIPE Guwahati is situated 45 kilometers from Guwahati Airport and 27 kilometer from Railway station towards the east.

1.2.2.3 LNIPE-North East Regional Center (NERC) at Guwahati (Assam) was established by the Institute from the academic session 2009-10 with the approval of Government of India. The Campus offers PG Diploma in Sports Coaching, B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. and Ph.D. Course.

1.2.2.4 The Institute building consists of an Academic Block & Administrative Block with resourceful Laboratories like; **Sports Psychology Lab, Sport Biomechanics Lab, sport Physiology Lab and Sport Training Lab** primarily focusing on research-based studies. Institute also possesses one of the best library in physical education and sport in the entire North East.

1.3 AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

- 1.3.1 The Institute has been graded as Category-I Deemed to be University by University Grant Commission (UGC) in 2018.
- 1.3.2 It has granted the status of Deemed to be University in 2018 under Section 12-B of the UGC Act, 1956.
- 1.3.3 It has awarded as “Excellent Institute of Physical Education in India” in the 11th National Education Summit & Awards 2017.
- 1.3.4 It also has awarded the India 2 Grand Jury Award in Sports and Co-Curricular Education in 2019.
- 1.3.5 The B.P.Ed and M.P.Ed programs of the Institute are recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE).
- 1.3.6 Granted Membership of International Association of Physical Cultural and Sports Universities-2019 at Kazakhstan.
- 1.3.7 Chief Post Master General Madhya Pradesh Circle Bhopal released “Special Cover” on LNIPE for completing 60th years of excellence (Diamond Jubilee) in 2017.

- 1.6.3 To Provide for high quality teaching and research and for the advancement knowledge and its dissemination through various research programs undertaken in-house by substantial number of full-time faculty/research scholars (PhDs and Post Doctoral) in diverse disciplines.
- 1.6.4 To Prepare highly qualified leaders in the field of Physical Education, another Inter-Disciplinary subjects and Sports/Games.
- 1.6.5 To Serve as Center of Excellence and innovations in physical education, and to undertake, promote and disseminate research and also publish literature in these fields.
- 1.6.6 To promote profession and academic leadership to other institutions in the field of physical education.
- 1.6.7 To provide vocational guidance and professional services to the people in this field.
- 1.6.8 To promote mass participation in physical education activities.
- 1.6.9 To undertake extra mural studies, extension programs and filed outreach activities for contributions to the development of the society.
- 1.6.10 To develop and promote programs of physical education and games/sports in Educational Institutions and other organizations.

1.11 HOSTEL AND MESS

It is mandatory for the students of B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed, to reside in the hostels and take their meals in the mess. Hostel & Mess Facility for students of other programs are subject to availability. A booklet containing rules and regulations regarding discipline and conduct in the Institute's hostel and mess is given to the students at the time of admission.

1.12 HEALTH CENTER

The Institute Health Center provides treatment on a nominal fee i.e. Rs. 1000/- per semester for ordinary injuries and ailments under the supervision of resident doctors. First-aid treatment for sports related injuries is also available. In case of emergency, the students are referred to government-approved hospitals for further treatment. In such cases, they will have to pay the cost of treatment. At the time of application, parents shall execute an indemnity form authorizing Medical Officers or Wardens to give consent for the administration of anesthesia or any necessary medical treatment involving risk in emergency situations. All students are required to follow the Institute's rules regarding health and medical services. Students are also insured under group Medi-claim Policy.

1.13 CO-CURRICULAR & EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Institute promotes cultural and literary activities through the Student Cultural Club and Literary Society respectively, by providing the students an opportunity to participate in dramatics, music, debates, symposia, quiz competitions etc. The students are encouraged to involve extensively in activities like NCC, NSS, Outreach Activities, Camping and Adventure Programs to develop leadership qualities and all-round personality development.

1.14 SPORTS PARTICIPATION

Competitive sports are an integral part of the academic programme of the Institute. Since attaining the status of Deemed to be a University, the Institute teams directly participate in the Inter University Tournaments in various games and sports. The Institute teams also participate at different levels as per its policy.

1.15 ADMISSION AND RESERVATIONS

- 1.15.1 The Institute is co-educational and admits candidates from India and abroad. For all courses, the reservation policy of Government of India is applicable. (Except for in-service candidate from defense and paramilitary for Diploma in Sports Coaching).
- 1.15.2 Three percent (3%) supernumerary seats (except program recognized by NCTE) in courses shall be available for the Ward quota (dependent son/daughter of permanent employees of LNIFE) including those on probation, retired and serving/retired/deceased employees; provided the candidates fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements and claims that he/she belongs to employee ward category in the application form. LNIFE employee wards category candidates are required to submit a certificate issued by the Registrar of LNIFE after certifying their family details from service book of the concerned employee. If Seats in the program recognized by the NCTE remain vacant, the remaining seats shall be distributed as per the reservation policy of GOI.
- 1.15.3 If the Ward quota seats are lying vacant in the programs recognized by the NCTE, it shall be filled as per the reservation policy from the merit list of respective program.
- 1.15.4 Direct Admission shall not be offered in the programs recognized by the NCTE.
- 1.15.5 Incomplete documents will lead to cancellation of admission. Once an admission is cancelled, it shall be final and cannot be reverted or withdrawn under any circumstances.

1.22 GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

The following conditions of admission shall apply to all the candidates seeking admission in different programs:-

- 1.22.1 Candidates expelled from any other Board/Institute/University or dismissed from Government service on disciplinary grounds and those who known as being involved in acts of crime and gross indiscipline or misconduct will not be eligible for admission. The Institute may approach the police for verification in this regard. After admission, if anybody found guilty in this regard, he/she will have to discontinue the course.
- 1.22.2 The medium of examination shall be either Hindi or English for all the programs.
- 1.22.3 Admission will be granted to the candidates at their own risk and candidate will be liable for wrong information (if any) furnished by them. If, at any point of time, if it came to notice, then admission granted will be cancelled and the candidate shall be asked to leave the Institute.

- 1.22.7 Online Application link for all program will be available on Institute website.
- 1.22.8 Admissions to all programs offered by the Institute will close on **September 15, 2026**.

1.24 ATTENDANCE, CONDUCT, REFUND OF FEE AND CAUTION MONEY

- 1.24.1 "Students must maintain 100% attendance across all subjects, activities, and course code of the total curriculum but, due to medical leave/personal leave, etc., a relaxation of 15% may be given. In exceptional and deserving cases, the Vice-Chancellor may give further relaxation of up to 10% in attendance. Prior to one month from the date of semester examinations the student must have complete 85% attendance. In exceptional and deserving cases, the Vice Chancellor may give further relaxation of up to 10% in attendance.
- 1.24.2 Students are expected to maintain exemplary conduct inside and outside the Institute. Institute provides Merit Scholarship to top 5% strength of each course (B.P.Ed.) M.P.Ed and M.A. Yoga). The amount of Merit Scholarship will be the total amount of fee and other charges (except caution money) paid by the student to the institute for the year.

1.28.2 Ph.D. SCHOLARSHIP

- 1.28.2.1 The Institute assists scholars in the administration and timely disbursement of various fellowships, including JRF, NFSC, NFOBC, and NFST, among others.
- 1.28.2.2 Scholarship to NET qualified Ph.D. Scholars will be awarded @ Rs.8000/- per month along with an Annual Contingency Rs.15000/- who are not getting any other scholarship such as JRF/SRF. The Scholarship will be granted on the basis of their performance in the Entrance Examination of Ph.D. (NET Score). This scholarship will be awarded every year to two (02) Scholars from each department.

1.28.3 PROF. R.P. SHARMA SCHOLARSHIP

The best footballers (one male and one female) will be awarded this scholarship amounting to Rupees one thousand (Rs. 1000/-) each year from the interest of the fixed deposit made by the family members of (Late) Prof. R.P. Sharma.

1.28.4 PROF. (LATE) JAYSHREE ACHARYA MEMORIAL SCHLOARSHIP

The Topper of Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed). Shall be awarded with an amount Rs.50,000/- on the Foundation Day of the Institute.

NOTE:

Institute facilitates in the process of various scholarships offered by the Central, States and Union Territory Government to their domiciled students. In addition, scholarships are also awarded by the North East Council. 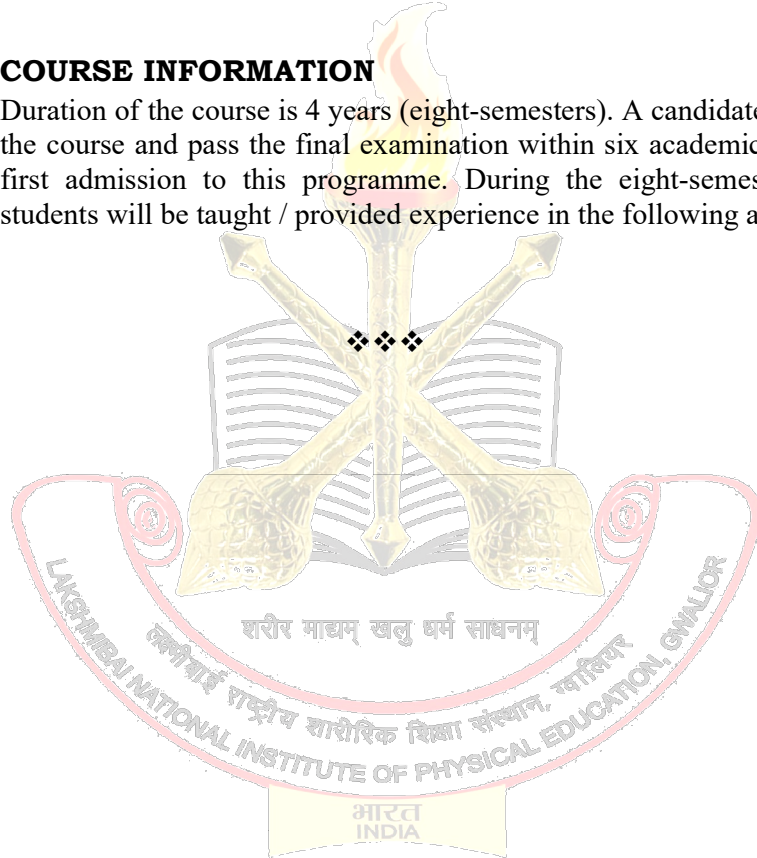
